Key Updates

- Addition of Extended Text data type
- Addition of reporting guidance on:

 - Foreign Input Identifiers
 - Material Inconsistency obligations

 - 'RELATIONSHIP' and 'ENTITYID' FDID roles
 - customerType values 'EMPLOYEE', 'BD', 'RIC'
 - registeredRepCRD and branchOfficeCRD for clearing firms and institutional customers
 - Updated registeredRepCRD to be Optional
 - ➤ Added a new Error code 22071 denoting that each FDID record must have at least one CAT Customer with trading capabilities

Extended Text Data Type

- The permitted range of ASCII values will be increased from the current range of **32-126** to allow all printable characters from **32-255**. This allows support of accents, umlauts, tildes, and similar characters which may be included in the customer name, addresses, or account names.
- ➤ Characters which are restricted from use in fields of the Text data type including commas, pipes, double quotes, and @s will be acceptable in fields with the Extended Text data type.
- > The extended range applies to the following **FDID** fields:
 - Account Name
 - Address Lines 1-4
 - City
 - Region Code (when Country is not US or CA)
- The extended range applies to the following Customer fields:
 - First, Middle, Last, Legal, and Doing Business As Names
 - Address Lines 1-4
 - City
 - Region Code (when Country is not US or CA)

Updates to Reporting Guidance

Foreign Input Identifiers

- ➤ The following hierarchy must be followed if more than one identifier type is available for a foreign CAT Customer:
 - National Registration or Tax Identifier (Natural Person or Legal Entity)
 - LEI (Legal Entity)
 - Country of Domicile and Passport Number (Natural Person)
 - Permanent Resident Identifier (Natural Person)

Updates to Reporting Guidance Cont'd

> role for 'RELATIONSHIP' and 'ENTITYID' FDIDs

For 'RELATIONSHIP' and 'ENTITYID' FDIDs, role(s) of associated customer(s) should be 'TRDHOLDER'

customerType

- 'EMPLOYEE' can only be used for Natural Person CAT Customers
- 'RIC' and/or 'BD' can only be used for Legal Entity CAT Customers

registeredRepCRD & branchOfficeCRD

- registeredRepCRD is now an Optional field when reported, it must be the CRD value of the representative
- ➤ Neither field is required for clearing firms reporting data of correspondents

Field Definition Updates

accountType of 'AVERAGE'

- > **R4**: Average price account
- > **R5**: Firm-owned average price account

doingBusinessAs

- > R4: The Doing Business As name for a sole proprietorship or other legal entity customer reported to CAIS using an SSN/ITIN as the Input Identifier.
- ➤ **R5**: The Doing Business As name for a sole proprietorship or other legal entity customer reported to CAIS using an SSN/ITIN as the Input Identifier. Must be populated when reporting a CAT Customer as a Natural Person record that is a sole proprietorship, trust, or otherwise conducts business under a name other than its legal name.

branchOfficeCRD

- ➤ **R4**: The Central Registration Depository system generated CRD Branch Number assigned when the CAT Reporter firm filed Form BR. Must be provided if known to the CAT Reporter firm.
- > **R5**: The CRD for the Branch Office to which the FDID record is assigned if applicable. Required if a customer account is assigned to a branch office other than the main office.

Glossary Additions

Account

For the purpose of the CAIS Technical Specification, the term Account is synonymous with Firm Designated ID (FDID). An Account may represent an account, Relationship ID, or Entity ID.

Natural Person

For purposes of CAT reporting, a Natural Person is a CAT Customer whose Input Identifier used to generate the Customer's TID is an SSN, ITIN, National Registration or Tax Identifier, Country of Domicile and Passport Number, or Permanent Resident Identifier.

Legal Entity

For purposes of CAT reporting, a Legal Entity is a CAT Customer whose Input Identifier used to generate the Customer's TID is an LEI or EIN.
